- so that higher education institutions may contribute to development and build bridges to surmount conflicts.


Offer expertise for academic collaboration

 so that academic and political leaders are able to make well-informed policy decisions.



North America








International mobility of academics and researchers

Total number of foreign academic staff and foreign professors at German higher education institutions since 2006, by key country of origin






Iranian Students in Germany, 2007-2016; number and by subject

Presence on site:

- DAAD-Information Center in Tehran
- 3 Lecturers at Shahid Beheshti University, University Teheran and University Isfahan

Cooperation with Iranian Ministries

- Memorandum of Understanding with Ministry of Science Research and Technology (2012) and regular Steering Committee Meetings
- German Iranian Scholarship Programme (GISP) together with MSRT: Short-Term Scholarships for Doctorate Candidates
- Deliberations with Ministry of Health and Medical Education on joint Scholarship Programme

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Individual scholarship-programmes:

- All academic levels, all fields, varied lengths of stays
- No subject-related quota
- Previous knowledge of German not required (for Iranians)
- Including health insurance and travel expenses
- Bi-nationally supervised Doctoral Degree (max 2 years, for Iranians)
- Doctoral Education (max 4 years, for Iranians)
- Research Stays for PhD-Candidates and PostDocs (1-10 months, both ways)
- Research Stays for established scientists (1-3 months, for Iranians)
- Short-Term Lectureships (1-6 months, for Germans)
- Conference and Academic Workshop participation (for Germans)



Individual scholarship-programmes:

- GISP German-Iranian Scholarship Programme
- Joint programme of MSRT and DAAD
- PhD-Candidates
- 6-9 months at a German University
- Monthly stipend, insurances, travel allowance, German language course
- Workshops/Conferences/Seminars
- Focus on DAAD-Alumni
- Funds for travel and accommodation expenses & for conference organisation in Iran
- Participation in conferences and lectures
- To participate in conferences, workshops and/or lectures in Iran
- Travel- and accommodation expenses

Institutional cooperation











Double Degrees



- At least two Higher Education Institutions as cooperation partners – one in Germany and one in the host country
- DAAD-funding primarily for mobility (workshops, seminars, courses, exchange)
- Duration between two and four years for each project
- Applying institution is the German HEI

Institutional cooperation

- PAGEL Partnerships for the Health Sector in Developing Countries
- Offer medical training and further education opportunities
- Development-related professional networks between students, alumni, and experts in the health sector are to be established
- Partnerships for Supporting Biodiversity in Developing Countries
- Enable partner institutions to offer study and qualification courses relating to biodiversity
- Integrate Biodiversity issues into focal areas of research
- Summer Schools
- In Germany or Iran
